2013-2014 budget review

- On February 28, 2013, the Mayor, Trustees Dill and Gaylord and Clerk-Treasurer Jane Murray met with Baldwin Business Services of Nunda, New York. The meeting was scheduled to discuss the 2013-2014 Tentative budgets and the current financial status of the Village for the next fiscal year. Tom Baldwin was encouraged with the recent spending freeze that was initiated in December 2012; however, those measures are not enough and the budget for 2013-2014 needs serious cutting. It was discussed raising the tax rate.
- Mayor Kenney was going to contact Town Assessor Lynn Wood to determine why the Village's assessed value has dropped significantly in years. Spending freeze will remain in effect until further notice.
- Departments were ask to cut \$50K
- Spending outweighed revenue
- Police department would like to hire 2 Full-time employees

Board of Trustees discussed upcoming talks regarding the Murray/Holley Fire department. Fireman's Field could be used to host Bocce games during the summer months.

Department Supervisor's should not be paid overtime for hours worked over forty. They are considered salary. Trustees suggested Atty. Sansone look into the issue.
