Local Law No.5 of the year 2013.

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 243-14 OF THE VILLAGE OF HOLLEY CODE PERTAINING TO FINES ASSOCIATED WITH PARKING VIOLATIONS

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Holley as follows:

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the Village of Holley to delineate restrictions on areas for parking within the confines of the Village of Holley, and

WHEREAS, section 243-14 of the Official Code of the Village of Holley currently sets forth fines associated with parking violations within the Village of Holley, and

WHEREAS, this proposed amendment modifies the current fine schedule set forth in section 243-14 of the Code of the Village of Holley as it pertains to parking violations, and

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved that the following proposed local law be published for public review in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law and the Village Law, and that a public hearing be held thereupon on the 23rd day of October, 2013, for the purposes of consideration of adoption of the proposed local law which reads as follows:

Local Law No.5 of the Laws of 2013 of the Village of Holley

I. AMENDMENT: - Section 243-14 of the Village of Holley Code is replaced with the following text:

| Prohibited Parking, posted | \$35.00 |
| Winter parking violation | \$40.00 |
| Overtime parking | \$35.00 |
| Parked blocked sidewalk | \$35.00 |
| Double parking | \$35.00 |
| Parking less than 15 ft. from fire hydrant | \$40.00 |
| Parking wrong side of curb | \$35.00 |
| Handicap parking (No permit) | \$100.00 |
| Handicap parking (No visible permit) | \$50.00 |
| Parking in a fire lane | \$40.00 |
| Parking on the sidewalk | \$35.00 |
| Expired Inspection | \$35.00 |
| Expired inspection over 60 days | \$45.00 |
| Parking between curb and sidewalk | \$35.00 |
| All other parking violations | \$35.00 |

II. AUTHORITY: The Legislative body of the State of New York has granted authority to local government units to adopt and amend local laws from time to time as necessary in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the persons and properties within such local municipality. In addition, the Legislative body of the State of New York has specifically deemed that the local government unit shall adopt a local law in certain situations. That, pursuant to such grant of authority, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 714 of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Holley, being the local legislative body of such municipality, is empowered to adopt a local law creating and/or modifying territories into the zoning districts of the Village of Holley.

The Village of Holley Board of Trustees has authorized that these changes be made to the Village of Holley Code and that same be implemented into, and enforced as set forth in the Village of Holley Code.

III. EFFECTIVE DATE OF AMENDMENT: The amendment as described above shall become effective upon the filing of this local law in the office of the Secretary of State.

Local Law No. 6 of the year 2013.

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 53-4 OF THE VILLAGE OF HOLLEY CODE INCREASING THE CONTRACT AMOUNTS UNDER THE PROCUREMENT POLICY

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Holley as follows:

WHEREAS, section 53-4 of the Official Code of the Village of Holley currently sets forth estimated amounts for certain types of contracts and methods of purchase associated with the Village of Holley procurement policy, and

WHEREAS, this proposed amendment modifies the current estimated amounts of a public works contract as set forth in section 53-4 of the Code of the Village of Holley, and

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved that the following proposed local law be published for public review in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law and the Village Law, and that a public hearing be held thereupon on the 23rd day of October, 2013, for the purposes of consideration of adoption of the proposed local law which reads as follows:

Local Law No. 6 of the Laws of 2013 of the Village of Holley

I. AMENDMENT: - Section 53-4 of the Village of Holley Code is replaced with the following text:

| Estimated Amount of Public Works Contract | Method of Purchase |
|--|---|
| \$250 to \$2,999 | Two (2) verbal quotations |
| \$3,000 to \$4,999 | Two (2) written/faxed quotations |
| \$5,000 to \$35,000 | Three (3) written/faxed quotations or written request for proposals |

II.
